

Oliwa District with numerous copper roofs, while after flood the outstandingly high concentrations of Cu were measured in downstream tank Nos. 3 (B – 64.9 mg/kg) and 2 (A – 1114.3 mg/kg), suggesting that Cu was transported downstream as a result of washing out of the sediments deposited in the middle run of Oliwa Stream by an extremely high flow.

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
